



**CCFG Scotland Meeting based in Lower Deeside  
Thursday 13th September 2018

This year's visit, to two estates Logie Coldstone and Glen Tanar near Aboyne in Aberdeenshire, will look at mainly pine silviculture but with a few other species in the mix.

**Please note** that the visit to Logie Coldstone will involve a walking tour of approximately 1.2 miles on forest tracks and over felled areas. There are no formal toilet facilities.

The plan is to leave cars here and combine into a number of 4-wheel drive vehicles for the day due to a rough road section in the afternoon. **We would appreciate volunteers with 4x4 vehicles who are happy to give others a lift in for the day.**

- Douglas fir and CCF
