- TITLE:** ***EXEMPLARY FOREST UNITS OF UNEVEN-AGED FORESTRY
IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC***
- SUBTITLE:** ***25 years of pure even-aged Norway spruce stands transformation
and Pro Silva principles application within Forest District Kocanda***
- PLACE:** **Hotel Medlov, Fryšava pod Žákovou horou, Czech Republic**
- DATE:** **25th and 26th October 2018**
- ABSTRACT:** Risks to our forests are increasing due to climate change effects in combination with consequences of historical forest management approaches. There is an obvious need to change present forest management. The importance to divert from silviculture systems of coniferous forest stands, that are homogenous both in tree species composition and age, was already a clear recommendation more than hundred years ago. Even at that time, there was sound evidence that such even-aged and single-species forests are sensitive to forest disturbances caused by both biotic and abiotic factors. Nevertheless, there are forest areas continually developing in the Czech Republic, where the transformation process has been applied for the last decades. First results of the long way to achieve stable, mixed and heterogeneous forest stands, effectively using self-regenerating, -organizing and -regulating processes and natural automation can evidently be demonstrated. This process is of interest beyond the Czech Republic, as many countries in Europe are facing the same situation and the need for forest transformation.

 - to foster the collaboration of PSB and the European Forest Risk Facility to jointly face and solve various forestry problems
